**MEC MAVHUNGU LERULE-RAMAKHANYA TO ADDRESS INSTRUCTIONAL LEADERSHIP PROGRAMME GRADUATION CEREMONY**

Limpopo MEC for Education, Mavhungu Lerule-Ramakhanya will today deliver the keynote address at the graduation ceremony of the Instructional Leadership Programme. The programme is a strategic partnership between the Limpopo Department of Education, the University of South Africa (UNISA) and the Education Training and Development Practices Sector Education and Training Authority (ETDP SETA).
