982 EDUCATORS GRADUATE IN STRATEGIC ICT IN EDUCATION PROGRAMME

Limpopo's Member of the Executive Council (MEC) for Education, Ms. Mavhungu Lerule-Ramakhanya, today congratulated 982 educators from all 10 districts of the province on completing the *Strategic Implementation of ICT in Education* programme, facilitated by the University of the Witwatersrand. The graduation ceremony was held at the Manna Tabernacle Church Hall outside Polokwane.

The educators, recruited from schools across Limpopo through the Education, Training, and Development Practices Sector Education and Training Authority (ETDP SETA), are poised to strengthen digital capacity in classrooms. They will now lead the integration of ICT tools into teaching practices, ensuring knowledge transfer across all grades.

This initiative aligns with the provincial 2025 theme, *"A Year of Academic Excellence and Teacher Development,"* which prioritises curriculum transformation, innovation, and the effective use of technology in education.

In addition, the province has enrolled approximately 600 educators in specialised *Coding and Robotics* training for the Foundation Phase, further advancing its commitment to equipping schools with 21st-century skills.
