LIMPOPO EDUCATION DISTRICTS READY FOR WINTER ENRICHMENT CAMPS

Today marks the end of the second term and the closing of schools in the Province. Limpopo Education MEC wishes all learners safe winter holidays and is calling on parents to ensure that learners stay safe and continue to engage in academic activities where possible. The holiday will not apply to grades 12 learners who are set for the camps from Saturday 28 June 2025.

Hundreds of matric learners are expected to be part of residential camps in 7 districts of the Province. The camps comprise of learners selected for various intervention programmes aimed at improving Maths and Science, progressed learners, learners at risk of failing Gateway Subjects and for the gifted learners amongst others.

MEC Lerule-Ramakhanya will visit the camps starting from next week to monitor progress and to motivate the class of 2025.

"We have set aside a budget for the intervention to assist our class to close identified gaps and to focus on Gateway subjects. This kind of intervention has assisted us to improve our results in the past 3 years. We are confident that our learners will cease the moment, harvest as much as they can as part of their preparations", said MEC Mavhungu Lerule-Ramakhanya.

The MEC will kick start the winter school enrichment monitoring programme in Capricorn South on Wednesday next week.
