A total of 101 576 full-time and 25 516 part-time candidates have been successfully registered on the examination system, admission letters have been issued and 1650 examination centres have been audited and verified.

The storage and distribution of question papers are secured under the Department's examination security protocols. Invigilators, chief invigilators and marking officials have received comprehensive training to ensure that examination conduct is professional, fair and transparent.
