**LIMPOPO EDUCATION MEC TO VISIT STORM DAMAGED SCHOOLS.**

Limpopo Education MEC Mavhungu Lerule-Ramakhanya will visit some of the storm damaged schools ahead of the start of 2025 academic year. Scores of schools in the Province were hit by a storm late last year. The tale of destruction has left some schools without roofs which may affect the start of the academic year.

The MEC will on Wednesday visit three schools in Vhembe, Malamulele East to monitor the intervention currently underway to ensure that learners have proper classes when schools reopen next week. The MEC has instructed her team to move swiftly in areas where minor repairs are needed and requested a relief in the form of mobile classes where the situation is severe.

One of the affected Schools has already commenced with the academic calendar for the year and the MEC will use the opportunity to motivate over 230 matric learners who started with their classes on Monday.
